**TEMPORARY ORDER**

(Section 134)

**WHEREAS** on June 5, 2008, the Nova Scotia Securities Commission ("Commission") Staff filed with the Commission a Notice (Ex Parte Application) for a temporary order in respect of 3062809 Nova Scotia Limited, World of Wisdom Publishing House, Terra Firma Publications Incorporated and Ronald George Davis and Laurie Harriett Davis;

**AND WHEREAS** 3062809 Nova Scotia Limited and Terra Firma Publications Incorporated are incorporated under the laws of Nova Scotia;

**AND WHEREAS** World of Wisdom Publishing House is a partnership registered by 3062809 Nova Scotia Limited;

**AND WHEREAS** Laurie Harriett Davis and Ronald George Davis are residents of Nova Scotia;

**AND WHEREAS** 3062809 Nova Scotia Limited, World of Wisdom Publishing House, Terra Firma Publications Incorporated, Ronald George Davis and Laurie Harriett Davis appear to have distributed and solicited securities in Nova Scotia without being registered to do so;

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order;

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission is of the opinion that the length of time required to conclude a hearing could be prejudicial to the public interest;

**AND UPON** reviewing the Affidavit of M. Lianne Bradshaw sworn June 4, 2008;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**

1. pursuant to sections 134(1)(b)(i) and 134(2) of the Act, all persons or companies shall immediately cease trading in all securities of 3062809 Nova Scotia Limited, World of Wisdom Publishing House, and Terra Firma Publications Incorporated; and
2. pursuant to section 134(1)(a) of the Act, Ronald George Davis and Laurie Harriett Davis cease contravening the Act;

for a period of fifteen days from the date of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
