ORDERS:

1. Service of the Notice of Pre-Hearing Conference issued January 8, 2018, Notice of Hearing issued January 8, 2018, Statement of Allegations dated January 3, 2018, and Identification List dated January 3, 2018 was properly effected on the Respondents in accordance with part 5 of the Rules.
2. Any notice or document required under the Rules to be served shall be sufficiently served on the Respondents at the following addresses:


3. The Hearing to consider the Statement of Allegations dated January 3, 2018 shall proceed in writing unless otherwise ordered or directed by the Commission, with the exception that the Director of Enforcement shall summons the Complainant to attend at the Hearing to provide oral evidence under oath or affirmation beginning on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 9:30a.m.
4. In addition to Tuesday, June 26, 2018 for the Hearing of this matter, the Parties shall reserve the following dates, from 9:30a.m. to 4:30p.m., to appear before the Commission in the event additional time is required:
 - Monday, July 23, 2018; and
 - Tuesday, July 24, 2018.
5. All Documents, information, and things disclosed in this proceeding shall be used for the purpose of this proceeding only, unless otherwise ordered or directed by the Commission.
6. The Respondents shall keep confidential all Documents, information, and things disclosed in this proceeding, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
7. The written Hearing of this matter shall proceed as follows:
 - a) On or before Wednesday, February 28, 2018, the Director of Enforcement shall provide written notice to the Respondents via personal service that all Documents and things in the possession and control of Staff that are relevant to this proceeding are available for inspection pursuant to part 8.1 of the Rules.
 - b) On or before Wednesday, April 11, 2018, the Director of Enforcement's written opening statement and all affidavit evidence to be relied on at the Hearing of this matter shall be filed with the Commission.
 - c) On or before Wednesday, April 11, 2018, written notice that the Director of Enforcement's opening statement and disclosure pursuant to part 8.2 of the Rules, including the affidavit evidence filed with the Commission as set out above, are prepared and ready for delivery shall be provided to the Respondents via personal service.
 - d) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from the Director of Enforcement, the Respondents shall provide written notice to the Director of Enforcement that they wish to receive the Director of Enforcement's opening statement and disclosure pursuant to part 8.2 of the Rules, and the address where the opening statement and disclosure shall be delivered.

- e) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from each Respondent, the Director of Enforcement shall then deliver the opening statement and disclosure pursuant to part 8.2 of the Rules to the Respondent from whom the notice was received.
- f) On or before Wednesday, May 30, 2018, the Respondents shall file with the Commission and deliver to the Director of Enforcement all evidence they intend to rely on at the Hearing of this matter. This evidence shall be tendered to the Commission in affidavit form.
- g) On or before Wednesday, May 30, 2018, the Respondents shall file with the Commission and deliver to the Director of Enforcement their remaining disclosure pursuant to part 8.3 of the Rules.
- h) On or before Wednesday, May 30, 2018, the Respondents shall file with the Commission and deliver to the Director of Enforcement their written closing summaries and arguments.
- i) On or before Wednesday, May 30, 2018, the Respondents may also file with the Commission and deliver to the Director of Enforcement their written opening statements if they see fit to do so.
- j) On or before Wednesday, June 13, 2018, the Director of Enforcement shall file with the Commission any written reply evidence, if applicable.
- k) On or before Wednesday, June 13, 2018, written notice that the Director of Enforcement's reply evidence is prepared and ready for delivery shall be provided to the Respondents via personal service, if applicable.
- l) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from the Director of Enforcement, the Respondents shall provide written notice to the Director of Enforcement that they wish to receive the Director of Enforcement's reply evidence, and the address where the reply evidence shall be delivered.
- m) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from each Respondent, the Director of Enforcement shall then deliver the reply evidence to the Respondent from whom the notice was received.
- n) On or before Friday, June 22, 2018, the Director of Enforcement's written closing summary and arguments shall be filed with the Commission.
- o) On or before Friday, June 22, 2018, written notice that the Director of Enforcement's closing summary and arguments are prepared and ready for delivery shall be provided to the Respondents via personal service.

- p) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from the Director of Enforcement, the Respondents shall provide written notice to the Director of Enforcement that they wish to receive the Director of Enforcement's closing summary and arguments, and the address where the closing summary and arguments shall be delivered.
- q) Promptly upon receipt of the above written notice from each Respondent, the Director of Enforcement shall then deliver the closing summary and arguments to the Respondent from whom the notice was received.
- r) On or before, Wednesday, May 30, 2018, written notice of the Respondents' intention to cross-examine any of the Director of Enforcement's witnesses on the evidence contained in their affidavits shall be filed with the Commission and delivered to the Director of Enforcement.
- s) On or before, Wednesday, June 13, 2018, written notice of the Director of Enforcement's intention to cross-examine any of the Respondents' witnesses on the evidence contained in their affidavits shall be filed with the Commission and delivered to the Respondents.
- t) On or before, Monday, June 18, 2018, written notice of the Respondents' intention to cross-examine any of the Director of Enforcement's witnesses on the reply evidence, if applicable, shall be filed with the Commission and delivered to the Director of Enforcement.
