(Section 151)**

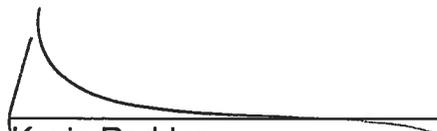
**WHEREAS:**

1. The Director made an order under section 134(1)(b)(i) of the Act on May 27, 2014 that all persons and companies shall immediately cease trading in all securities of the Respondent, directly or indirectly, until further order by the Director or the Commission (the “Cease Trade Order”);
2. The Cease Trade Order was made because the Respondent failed to file Annual Financial Statements (the “Disclosure”) for the year ended December 31, 2013 by May 20, 2014;
3. The Respondent filed the Disclosure on November 25, 2014 and is no longer on the CEDIF non-compliance list; and
4. The Director is of the opinion that to do so would not be prejudicial to the public interest.

**IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to section 151 of the Act, that the Cease Trade Order is revoked.
