**NOTICE OF HEARING
(Section 134(5) of the Act)**

TAKE NOTICE pursuant to section 134(5) of the Act that the Nova Scotia Securities Commission (the “Commission”) will hold a hearing at the offices of the Commission located at the Joseph Howe Building, 2nd Floor, 1690 Hollis Street, Halifax, Nova Scotia on Tuesday , the 16th. day of December, 2003 at 9:30 o’clock in the forenoon or as soon thereafter as the hearing can be held;

AND TAKE NOTICE that the purpose of the hearing will be for the Commission to consider the application of Commission staff for a Cease Trade Order pursuant to section 134(1)(b)(ii)of the Act;

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Commission will consider the status of a Temporary Cease Trade Order made by the Commission on the 3rd. day of December 2003 in respect to all trading, direct or indirectly by each of the Corporate Respondents and Respondents in the securities of the Corporate Respondents;

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Commission will consider and determine whether or not it is in the public interest to issue a Cease Trade Order under the provision of section 134(1) upon such terms and conditions as the Commission deems appropriate;

BY REASON OF the allegations set out in the Statement of Allegations of Staff of the Commission and such additional allegations as counsel may advise and the Commission may permit;

AND TAKE NOTICE that any party to the proceeding may be represented by counsel if that party attends or submits evidence at the hearing;

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that upon failure of any party to attend at the hearing, the hearing may proceed in the absence of that party and such party is not entitled to any further notice of the proceeding.
