The Commission creates a new website to better serve Nova Scotians

Halifax – The Nova Scotia Securities Commission has a new and improved website that provides clear and concise information about the regulation of Nova Scotia capital markets.

“We’ve designed a new user-friendly website to help educate and provide information to protect investors,” says Tanya Wiltshire, Communications Coordinator for the Nova Scotia Securities Commission. “One important investor protection feature we’ve added is an online Report a Scam form for people to submit complaints directly to us.”
