**ORDER**

(respecting private and confidential information of non-parties)

**WHEREAS** the Director of Enforcement for the Nova Scotia Securities Commission ("Commission") is required to make disclosure pursuant to *Rule 15-501 General Rules of Practice and Procedure* ("Rules") at least 15 days before the date on which the hearing is to commence;

**AND WHEREAS** compliance with the Rules requires disclosure of documents that relate to persons and/or entities who are not parties to this proceeding;

**AND WHEREAS** counsel for the Director of Enforcement for the Commission, Stephanie Atkinson, has conducted a review of the documents to be disclosed and has noted references to personal information of non-parties, and the redaction of such information would require a significant commitment of time and resources, thereby considerably delaying the progress of this proceeding;

**AND WHEREAS** it is important to protect the private information of non-parties consistent with securing the most expeditious and least expensive determination of every hearing before the Commission pursuant to section 18.5 of the Rules;

**AND UPON** receiving a request for direction from counsel for the Director of Enforcement for the Commission, Stephanie Atkinson, on how to proceed with the disclosure in this proceeding;

**AND UPON** obtaining the consent of counsel for the Respondents, Jane O'Neill;


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Respondents agree to be, and are bound by the terms and conditions of this Order;
2. Once a Respondent receives the disclosure from the Director of Enforcement for the Commission pursuant to the Rules, he agrees to keep and treat all documents and information relating to persons and/or entities who are non-parties to this proceeding confidential, unless otherwise ordered; and

3. All documents and information disclosed in this proceeding shall be used for the purposes of this proceeding only, unless otherwise ordered.




